The enclosed Confirmation Card confirms that you have been entered as a figure skating competitor in the 2004 Badger State Winter Games. It also provides information specific to you about the figure skating competition. **PLEASE CHECK THIS INFORMATION CAREFULLY.** If you are not listed as you had originally entered, or as we had agreed to modify your entry in a subsequent phone call, contact me immediately.

Also note the following:

- **Check-in** – A check-in desk will be open at the Youth Building in Marathon Park between 6:00 pm and 9:00 pm Thursday night, February 5. On Friday, Saturday, and Sunday, check-in will be at the rinks.
- **Arena Locations** - Rinks 1 and 2 are in the Multi-purpose building at Marathon Park (Stewart Avenue exit from Highway 51/39). Rink 3 (Greenheck Arena) is at the DC Everest High School in Schofield (corner of Jelinek and Alderson). The Greenheck Arena and the Marathon Park multipurpose buildings are about 20 minutes driving time apart.
- **Schedule** - The Confirmation Sheet enclosed with this letter that bears your name also lists the events our records indicate you will be participating in and the time these events are scheduled to occur. Some skaters will have a tight schedule between the Greenheck Arena and Marathon Park so we will do our best to stay on schedule. Nevertheless, **all competitors should try to be at the rink at least 45 minutes prior to their scheduled skate time** because we may start events up to 15 minutes earlier than scheduled. - **Practice Ice** – If you requested practice ice with your registration the assigned times are indicated on your confirmation sheet. Remaining practice ice will be available at the registration desk in 20-minute segments for \$5.00 per segment. Synchronized teams that have not already done so can arrange to rent the entire sheet of ice for \$75 by calling Jennifer Stanz prior to February 3 at 715/675-0166.
- **Synchronized teams** - As a matter of general information, the Greenheck Arena is Olympic size (100x200) and the teams will enter the rink near the blue line with the audience and judges at their back. Exit will be at the north end of the rink (which will be to your right as you enter the ice). Dressing rooms will be assigned and the assignments will be posted at the registration desk. Four of the seven dressing rooms are at rink level with rubber flooring. Three dressing rooms are one floor above without rubber matting, so bring skate guards. The upstairs dressing rooms have lockers available, so bring locks if you're assigned to an upstairs room and would like to use the lockers. Trophies to the winning Synchronized teams will be presented on-ice and we will follow a procedure similar to previous years. After skating their programs, teams should remain in their skating attire in the section reserved for them in the bleachers.
- **Awards and Qualifying Round Procedure** – Some events have qualifying rounds. The top three places in the qualifying rounds will receive pins and move on to the final round, where the top three places will receive medals. The following events are qualifying rounds:

The top three places in both the qualifying rounds and the final rounds will receive awards. Please remain in your skating attire until results have been posted. If you are an award recipient, report to the awards area immediately following the posting of results. The **schedule for final rounds** will be posted at the awards area and on the results board.

- **Photos/videos/flowers/ medal engraving** - All will be available at a nominal fee. Award winners will have their photo taken as a group. Any skater may have an individual photo taken on a time-available basis.
