General Information

Eligibility: All competitors must be either: 1) a member in good standing of a club having membership in U.S. Figure Skating; 2) an individual member of U.S. Figure Skating; or 3) a member of a national figure skating association that is a member of the ISU. Entries from members of clubs with a probationary status will be accepted provided the entry is accompanied by a signed certification by the skater that he or she is properly qualified to participate in the event(s) entered. Skaters may compete in as many disciplines as qualified by age and test level, but may compete in only one event per discipline. Competitors may enter both team and solo dance events. Age and test qualifications as of September 15, 2004 (close of entries), will determine classification. All skaters must skate at or one level above their highest test level.

Entries: Entries must be postmarked no later than September 15, 2004. Late entries will be accepted at the discretion of the Competition Committee and will require a \$25.00 fee. No refunds will be granted unless the committee eliminates an event. Except as stated herein, the competition will be conducted according to the rules of U.S. Figure Skating as set forth in the 2004-2005 Rule Book.

Registration Desk: The Registration Desk will be open starting Thursday, October 28, 2004 from 1:00 pm through 6:00 pm, and will be open during all scheduled events.

Schedule: Please include a self-addressed stamped envelope to receive a tentative schedule of events. An official schedule will also be available at the Registration Desk. A tentative schedule will be posted as early as possible on the IceWorks website at www.iceworkssc.org.

Age Categories: The following age categories apply to all events (unless otherwise specified):

Young Adult	18 to 24 years
Class I	25 to 35 years
Class II	36 to 45 years
Class III	46 to 55 years
Class IV	56 years & over

All age categories may be divided or combined (except in the case of Young Adult) depending on the number of registrations. There must be two (2) or more entries to hold an event. Proof of age (driver's license, passport or other photo ID) may be required.

Music: Cassette tapes or CDs must be clearly marked with the skater's name and event. Tapes must be rewound. CDs must have only one (1) track per CD in a format that is readable. All music must be turned into the registration desk at least one (1) hour prior to the event. We recommend that all skaters bring a backup tape for each event entered. All music must be picked up by the end of the competition. Unclaimed music will not be mailed back to competitors.

Rink: All events will be held at IceWorks Skating Complex, a full-service arena featuring 4 ice surfaces, 2 restaurants, pro shop, and fitness center, located 10 minutes from Wilmington, DE and 20 minutes from the Philadelphia International Airport.

Awards

Medals will be presented to the 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th place finishers in each event.

Practice Ice

Practice ice will be available throughout the competition. Official practice ice sessions will be offered on Friday, October 29th and Saturday, October 30th at a cost of \$15.00 per 30-minute session. A schedule will be determined after the close of entries (September 15, 2004). A sign-up form will be mailed to registrants who include a self-addressed, stamped envelope. The official practice ice schedule will also be posted on the Club's website: www.iceworkssc.org and available at the Registration Desk.

Additional freestyle time will be offered on a first come, first serve basis (subject to availability) during the following times on general club sessions for a walk-on fee of \$12.00 per 45 minute session:

Freestyle Events

Masters – Must have passed at least the Intermediate FS Test or the 3rd Figure Test prior to October 1, 1977, and/or the Adult Gold FS Test. Music not to exceed 3:40.

Gold – Must have passed at least the Adult Silver and/or Adult Gold FS Test, no higher than the standard Juvenile FS Test or the ISI Freestyle 6 or the 2nd Figure Test prior to October 1, 1977. Music not to exceed 2:40.

Silver – Must have passed the Adult Bronze FS Test and no higher than the Adult Silver or Juvenile FS Test. Axels are permitted, no double jumps allowed. Music not to exceed 2:10.

Bronze – Must have passed at least the Pre-Bronze FS Test and no higher than the Adult Bronze or Preliminary FS Text. No axels or double jumps allowed. Music not to exceed 1:40.

Pre-Bronze – Must have passed no higher than the Adult Pre-Bronze or Pre-Preliminary FS Test. All single jumps, except Lutz and Axel are allowed. Music not to exceed 1:40.

No-Test – May not have passed any USFSA skating tests. Only half jumps, Salchow, and Toe-Loop jumps are allowed. Music not to exceed 1:30.

Young Adult Gold (18 to 24 years) – Must have passed at least the Intermediate FS Test and/or the ISI Freestyle 7 Test. Music not to exceed 2:40.

Young Adult Silver (18 to 24 years) – Must have passed the Juvenile FS Test and/or the ISI Freestyle 5, no higher than the Intermediate FS Test or ISI Freestyle 6 Test. Music not to exceed 2:10.

Young Adult Bronze (18 to 24 years) – Must have passed the Preliminary FS Test and/or ISI Freestyle 3 Test, no higher than the Pre-Juvenile FS Test or ISI Freestyle 4 Test. Axels are permitted, no double jumps are allowed. Music not to exceed 1:40.

Young Adult Pre-Bronze (18 to 24 years) – Must have passed no test higher than the Preliminary FS Test or ISI Freestyle 3. No Axels or double jumps allowed. Music not to exceed 1:40.

Young Adult No-Test -- May not have passed any USFSA skating tests. Only half jumps, Salchow, and Toe-Loop jumps are allowed. Music not to exceed 1:30.

Pairs Events

(See SSR 6.11-6.14 and CR 109.00, Table C). Both partners must be at least 25 years of age.

Masters Pairs – One partner in the Masters Pairs event must have passed at least one of the following tests: the standard Intermediate Pair test or the standard Intermediate FS test. The other partner must meet the requirements for this level or must have passed no less than one level lower (Adult Gold Pair test, Adult Gold FS test, standard Juvenile Pair test, or standard Juvenile FS test). For purposes of these requirements, the Adult Gold Pair and Gold FS tests are considered to be one level lower than the standard Intermediate Pair and FS tests. Music not to exceed 3:40.

Adult Silver Pairs – One partner must have passed at least one of the following: the Adult Silver Pair test and no higher, Adult Silver FS test and no higher, standard Juvenile Pair test and no higher, or standard Pre-Juvenile FS test and no higher. The other partner must meet the requirements for this level or must have passed no less than one level lower (Adult Bronze Pair or Bronze FS test, standard Preliminary Pair or Preliminary FS test). Music not to exceed 2:40.

Adult Gold Pairs – One partner must have passed at least one of the following: Adult Gold Pair test and no higher, Adult Gold FS test and no higher, standard Juvenile Pair or Juvenile FS test and no higher. The other partner must meet the requirements for this level or must have passed no less than one level lower (Adult Silver Pair or Silver FS, standard Juvenile Pair or Pre-Juvenile FS test). Music not to exceed 3:10.

Adult Bronze Pairs – Both partners must have passed at least one of the following: Adult Bronze Pair test and no higher, Adult Bronze FS test and no higher, standard Preliminary Pair or Preliminary FS test and no higher. Music not to exceed 2:10.

Compulsory Moves Events

Moves must be performed without music and in any order with connecting steps necessary to link the various moves together. Mandatory deductions will be taken for unlisted or additional elements such as jumps, spins, repetitions or unsuccessfully executed moves. Skaters must skate at or one level above their highest FS Test.

Gold/Masters – Required Elements: Axel, Lutz-Loop Combination, Waltz – Half Loop – Flip Combination, Circular footwork sequence, Camel - Back Sit Spin (minimum 4 revolutions each), Layback (ladies) or Cross-Foot (Men) Spin. Time not to exceed 2:00. (Full ice)

Silver – Required Elements: Flip, Loop, Waltz – Half Loop – Salchow Combination, Camel – Sit Spin (no change of foot, minimum 6 revolutions), Back Spin, Circular Footwork Sequence. Time not to exceed 1:30. (Half ice)

Bronze – Required Elements: Salchow, Waltz - Toe-Loop Combination, Loop, Sit Spin (minimum 3 revolutions), Circular Footwork Sequence. Time not to exceed 1:15. (Half ice)

Pre-Bronze – Required Elements: Waltz Jump, Toe-Loop, Half Flip, One Foot Spin (minimum 3 revolutions), Spiral. Time not to exceed 1:00. (Half ice)

No-Test – Required elements are two-foot spin (minimum 3 revolutions), Forward Edges (minimum 3 outside and 2 inside, skated consecutively), Bunny Hop, Lunge. Time not to exceed 1:00. (Half ice)

Young Adult Gold (18 to 24 years) -- Required Elements: Axel, Lutz-Loop Combination, Waltz – Half Loop – Flip Combination, Circular footwork sequence, Camel - Back Sit Spin (minimum 4 revolutions each), Layback (ladies) or Cross-Foot (Men) Spin. Time not to exceed 2:00. (Full ice)

Young Adult Silver (18 to 24 years) -- Required Elements: Flip, Loop, Waltz – Half Loop – Salchow Combination, Camel – Sit Spin (no change of foot, minimum 6 revolutions), Back Spin, Circular Footwork Sequence. Time not to exceed 1:30. (Half ice)

Young Adult Bronze (18 to 24 years) -- Required Elements: Salchow, Waltz - Toe-Loop Combination, Sit Spin (minimum 3 revolutions), Circular Footwork Sequence. Time not to exceed 1:15. (Half ice)

Young Adult Pre-Bronze (18 to 24 years) -- Required Elements: Waltz Jump, Toe-Loop, Half Flip, One Foot Spin (minimum 3 revolutions), Spiral. Time not to exceed 1:00. (Half ice)

Young Adult No-Test -- Required elements are two-foot spin (minimum 3 revolutions), Forward Edges (minimum 3 outside and 2 inside, skated consecutively), Bunny Hop, Lunge. Time not to exceed 1:00. (Half ice)

Spin Events

Spins must be skated exactly as stated, but may be skated in any order. Connecting steps may be used, but will not affect scoring. All Spin Events are skated without music and on half ice surface. Skaters must skate at or one level above their highest FS Test.

Gold/Masters – Required Elements: One solo spin (minimum 5 revolutions), one jump spin (minimum 4 revolutions), and one combination spin with only one change of foot and at least two changes of position (minimum 4 revolutions each foot). Time not to exceed 1:30.

Silver – Required Elements: One camel spin (minimum 3 revolutions), one layback, attitude or sit spin (minimum 4 revolutions), one combination spin with only one change of position – change of foot optional (minimum 3 revolutions each position). Time not to exceed 1:30.

Bronze – Required Elements: One foot upright spin (minimum 4 revolutions), camel spin (minimum 3 revolutions), sit spin (minimum 3 revolutions). Time not to exceed 1:30.

Pre-Bronze – Required Elements: One foot upright spin (minimum 3 revolutions, optional leg position), two foot spin (entry optional, minimum 3 revolutions), one sit spin, broken leg, or attitude (minimum 3 revolutions). Time not to exceed 1:15.

Young Adult Gold (18 to 24 years) -- Required Elements: One solo spin (minimum 5 revolutions), one jump spin (minimum 4 revolutions), and one combination spin with only one change of foot and at least two changes of position (minimum 4 revolutions each foot). Time not to exceed 1:30.

Young Adult Silver (18 to 24 years) -- Required Elements: One camel spin (minimum 3 revolutions), one layback, attitude or sit spin (minimum 4 revolutions), one combination spin with only one change of position – change of foot optional (minimum 3 revolutions each position). Time not to exceed 1:30.

Young Adult Bronze (18 to 24 years) -- Required Elements: One foot upright spin (minimum 4 revolutions), camel spin – (minimum 3 revolutions), sit spin (minimum 3 revolutions). Time not to exceed 1:30.

Young Adult Pre-Bronze (18 to 24 years) -- Required Elements: One foot upright spin (minimum 3 revolutions, optional leg position), two foot spin (entry optional, minimum 3 revolutions), one sit spin, broken leg, or attitude (minimum 3 revolutions). Time not to exceed 1:15.

Improvisational Skating

Male and female skaters may be combined for this event. Skaters will spontaneously create a program using music chosen by the Competitions Committee. Skaters may skate at or one level above their current FS Test. This event is open to skaters 18 years of age or older.

The event will be conducted as follows:

- a) Music will be selected from modern, contemporary pieces
- b) Music will be played twice during on-ice warm-up
- c) Skaters will return to the locker room after warm-up and remain there while waiting for their turn to skate
- d) No coaches or other assistants are allowed in the locker room or at the boards
- e) No double jumps allowed

Competitors will be judged according to:

- a) Choreography – Suitability of program sequence and elements to the music and theme
- b) Originality – Creativity of chosen theme carried throughout the entire program
- c) Showmanship – Presentation to the audience and overall style

Maneuver Teams

Each skater may enter only one Maneuver Team event. Teams will consist of at least 3 skaters and no more than 5 skaters at the prescribed test level. No skater may perform more than two elements. Skaters on a team do not have to represent the same club. Each team should submit one team application form including the team's entry fee. Each team should construct a sign or poster including their team's name.

Dance Events

PAIRS DANCE EVENTS:

In the Dance Events, one partner must be at least 25 years of age and the other must be at least 18 years of age as of the close of entries.

Gold Dance – One partner in the Adult Gold Dance event must have passed at least one Gold/Adult Gold Dance and the other partner must have passed at least one Pre-Gold/Adult Pre-Gold Dance. Dances: Viennese Waltz, Silver Samba.

Pre-Gold Dance – One partner in the Pre-Gold Dance event must have passed at least one Pre-Gold/Adult Pre-Gold Dance and the other partner must have passed at least one Silver/Adult Silver Dance. Neither partner may have completed the Gold/Adult Gold Dance Test. Dances: Tango, Blues.

Silver Dance – One partner in the Silver Dance event must have passed at least one Silver/Adult Silver Dance and the other partner must have passed at least one Pre-Silver/Adult Pre-Silver Dance. Neither partner may have passed more than one Pre-Gold/Adult Pre-Gold Dance. Dances: European Waltz, Rocker Foxtrot.

Pre-Silver Dance – Both partners in the Pre-Silver Dance must have passed at least one Pre-Silver/Adult Pre-Silver Dance. Neither partner may have passed more than one Silver/Adult Silver Dance. Dances: Ten Fox, European Waltz.

Bronze Dance – One partner in the Bronze Dance event must have passed at least one Pre-Silver/Adult Pre-Silver Dance and the other partner must have passed at least one Bronze/Adult Bronze Dance. Neither partner may have passed more than one Silver/Adult Silver Dance. Dances: Fiesta Tango, Swing Dance.

Pre-Bronze Dance – Both partners in the Pre-Bronze Dance must have completed the Pre-Bronze Dance test, but no higher than the Bronze Dance test. Dances: Canasta Tango, Swing Dance.

ORIGINAL DANCE EVENTS:

See SSR 11.00. In the event less than three entries are received in a single category, two or more of the following categories may be combined. Vocal music is permitted. Music is not to exceed 2:15.

Championship – One partner in the Championship Original Dance event must have passed at least one Championship/Adult Championship Dance and the other partner must have passed at least one Gold/Adult Gold Dance.

Gold – One partner in the Gold Original Dance event must have passed at least one Gold/Adult Gold Dance and the other partner must have passed at least one Pre-Gold/Adult Pre-Gold Dance.

Pre-Gold – One partner in the Pre-Gold Original Dance event must have passed at least one Pre-Gold/Adult Pre-Gold Dance and the other partner must have passed at least one Silver/Adult Silver Dance.

SOLO DANCE EVENTS:

Competitors in the Solo Dance events may compete at the test level that he or she has partially tested, completed, or one level higher than he or she has completed. Male and female skaters may be combined in this event. Skaters must be 25 years of age or older as of the close of entries.

Gold Open Solo – (May have passed International dances) Dances: Westminster Waltz and Quickstep

Pre-Gold Solo – Dances: The Blues and Paso Doble

Silver Solo – Dances: Tango and Rocker Foxtrot

Pre-Silver Solo – Dances: 14 Step and the Foxtrot

Bronze Solo – Dances: Hickory Hoedown and Ten Fox

Pre-Bronze Solo – Dances: Cha Cha and Fiesta Tango

Preliminary Solo – Dances: Dutch Waltz and Canasta Tango

Interpretive Skating Events

The Adult and Masters Interpretive Skating Events consist of a variety of skating moves and elements designed to enhance the skater's own interpretation of the music. Axels and double jumps will not be permitted. Costumes that enhance the performance by appropriately reflecting the character of the music and theme will be considered in the judging. Props on the ice will not be permitted (hand-held props may be used). No "special effects" such as water, fire, pyrotechnics, dry ice, smoke or loud noises will be permitted. Costumes that contain particles that may mar or leave anything on the ice surface are considered unsafe and will not be allowed. This includes feathers, boas, and excessive beading.

In all Interpretive Events, vocal music is permitted and age categories will be the same as for Free Skating events. Skaters will be judged on their ability to interpret the music and develop a theme by using their skating skills. The judges will use two marks.

In marking the skating techniques of the program, these aspects must be considered:

1) style; 2) ease, flow, power and depth of edges; 3) ability to vary the speed and direction of skating; 4) variety of expressive and innovative moves; 5) succession of movement within the program; and 6) utilization of space and ice coverage.

In marking the presentation of the program, the following aspects must be considered:

1) interpretation of the music or theme; 2) musical timing and understanding of the music; 3) use of entire body to develop artistic expression; 4) creativity; 5) variation in tempo, emotion, and movements; 6) choreography; 6) suitability of music to the skater; and 7) internal motivation of movement and expression projected to the audience.

Masters Interpretive Free Skating – A competitor must meet the minimum requirements for the Adult Gold Free Skating event, any Masters Free Skating or Pairs Event, or have passed at least one Adult Silver or Standard Silver Dance Test. Music not to exceed 1:40.

Adult Interpretive Free Skating – A competitor must meet the requirements for the Adult Pre-Bronze, Bronze or Silver Free Skating event, or have passed the complete Pre-Bronze Dance Test, and have passed no higher than the complete Adult Pre-Silver or Standard Pre-Silver Dance Test. Music not to exceed 1:40.

Young Adult Masters Interpretive (18 to 24 years) – A competitor must meet the minimum requirements for the Young Adult Gold Free Skating event, any Masters Free Skating or Pair Event, or have passed at least one Silver Dance Test. Music not to exceed 1:40.

Young Adult Interpretive Free Skating (18 to 24 years) – A competitor must meet the requirements for the Young Adult Pre-Bronze, Bronze or Silver Free Skating event, or have passed the complete Pre-Bronze Dance Test, and have passed no higher than the complete Pre-Silver Dance Test. Music not to exceed 1:40.
