From Stevens Point : Take Hwy. 51 South to Hwy 33. Stay on Hwy 33 to Beaver Dam



# DIVISION REQUIREMENTS

Teams may be a USFSA, ISIA, or non-registered synchronized team. Group size for introductory levels shall be not less than 8 and no more than 16 skaters. Group size for all other levels shall be not less than 8 and no more than 26. A minimum of 75% of the skaters must meet the age requirements as set forth below with the exception of Youth which is 50%.

A skater may skate on one limited team or in the open divisions but not both. Open teams may enter more than one open category, using different music and a different routine, with a minimum change of six skaters as long as each team meets the age requirements.
