SKATER GROUPINGS

The most challenging aspect of organizing a clinic of this kind is grouping skaters correctly. Skaters will be divided into groups by skill.

GROUP I – skaters who are extremely skilled – Individuals with high tests or many years of synchro experience. Able to perform most skills with ease - 3-turns, mohawks, brackets, choctaws, spirals, lunges, batters, spread eagles, some spins, jumps (1/2), crossovers, stops.

Group II A – skaters who are at the intermediate skill level – some synchro experience. Can perform most of the skills described above.

Group II B – skaters who are at the intermediate skill level – some synchro experience. Can perform some of the skills described above.

Group III – skaters who are at the beginner/advanced beginner level. May be familiar with some of the skills described above.

- ◆ Please indicate on your registration form which group you would like to participate in.
- ◆ Skaters who appear to be placed incorrectly (in a group too advanced or not advanced enough) will be moved to the appropriate group at the discretion of the Clinic Director.
- ◆ We recognized the difficulty in placing skaters appropriately & would appreciate your cooperation & flexibility.
