General Information

1. Synchronized skaters of all ages (Youth through Senior) are welcome. Coaches, of all levels, are encouraged to attend. Team and individual registrations are welcomed.
2. Registration will take place Wednesday, June 15 from 6-8pm at Lawson Ice Arena. Resident Plan skaters (and parents) will then be escorted to the Residence Hall by a Camp Staff member where they will unload - skaters will remain there for the evening. The camp will begin Thursday morning, June 16 at approximately 8:30am and will conclude Sunday, June 19 at approximately 1pm.
3. Each skater should bring appropriate dress for all on-ice sessions (a dark skirt, dress or pants), recreational clothing for off-ice sessions, including athletic footwear, a swimming suit and toiletries.
4. Each team of skaters will be supervised by a Bronco Camp Counselor who will be present during all activities.
