General Information

The Sunshine Adult Challenge of Florida is the first and only Adult Only competition in the State of Florida, open to all adult skaters in both U.S. Figure Skating and ISI. Following the model of our famous fellow competition "The Peach Classic," the Sunshine Adult Challenge wants to provide adult skaters in the US with more competition venues to perform and share, not only a great time, but a time to reinforce friendship and good sportsmanship.

Eligibility

Except for the No-Test events, all competitors must be: (1) members in good standing of a club having membership in the U.S. Figure Skating; (2) an individual member of the U.S. Figure Skating; (3) a member of a probationary club, provided that the entry is accompanied by a signed certification by the skater that he/she is properly qualified to participate in the event(s) entered; (4) a member of a national figure skating association that is a member of the International Skating Union (ISU).

Skaters may compete in as many disciplines as qualified by test level and age, but may compete in only one (1) event per discipline; competitors may enter both solo dance and couples dance events. Age and test qualifications as of **Friday, December 10, 2004**, will determine classification.

Age Categories

Young Adult	18 to 24 years
Class I	25 to 35 years
Class II	36 to 45 years
Class III	46 to 55 years
Class IV	56 years & over

For Adult categories Proof of age is required for all entrants. A copy of birth certificate, passport, driver's license or similar proof of age is considered acceptable; however, the Organizing Committee reserves the right to require additional documentation.

Conduct of Events

All events will be conducted according to **3600, 4000, and 4200** unless otherwise specified in this announcement. Skaters and coaches shall refer to the "Information for Competitors, Coaches and Parents" section in the 2005 revision of the Official U.S. Figure Skating Rulebook (p. 63) for specific requirements of their respective events.

All age categories, may be divided (except Young Adult) depending on the number of entries. There must be at least two (2) entries to hold an event. Skating Club of South Florida, Inc. reserves the right to divide any event if necessary and to cancel any event (with full refund of entry fee).

Judging System, Events and Awards

The "Closed System of Judging" will be used in accordance with **2503**. **All events are final rounds**. Medals will be awarded for First, Second, Third and Fourth place winners in each group. Awards will be presented off-ice at scheduled intervals throughout the competition.

Ties

In Dance, Solo Dance and Moves-in-the-Field events, ties will be broken first by total ordinals of majority; if still tied, then the second dance or move will break the tie.

Conduct of Competitors, Coaches, Parents and Officials

All competitors, coaches, parents and officials are expected to follow basic rules of courtesy and conduct and are bound to follow the rules set forth in **GR 1.02, GR 1.03 and GR 1.04**. Judges are also bound to abide by the rules set forth in **JR 1.00**. Competitors and coaches shall refer to **3570** in regards to the conduct of competitors during competition.

Complaints, Protests and Appeals

Complaints, protests, and appeals will be handled in accordance with **3580**.

Rink Facility

All events will be held at Pines Ice Arena (a twin rink facility) located at 12425 Taft Street; Pembroke Pines, Florida 33028. Each surface measures 200' by 85' with rounded corners and hockey barriers. The facility has locker rooms, a snack bar, restaurant, pro-shop, ample seating and viewing areas. for directions and rink information. As a request, please refrain from calling Pines Ice Arena for issues regarding the Sunshine Open Challenge of Florida.

Entries

Entries must be postmarked no later than **Friday, December 10, 2004**. Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the LOC and the referee according to **3231**, and will be subject to a twenty (\$20) dollars late fee charge.

3222 applies to accidents. Refunds will only be made in accordance with **3235**.

Music

All competition music must be on cassette tape or CD and clearly labeled with the skater's name, club name, event, coach's name and running time on the side that is to be played. **No mini discs or DAT's**. CDs must have only one (1) track per CD in a format that is widely readable by most CD players. Please rewind all tapes to the leader. **Music must be turned in at the registration desk at the time of check-in, and no later than one hour before the skater's first event.** We recommend that all skaters bring a backup copy for each event entered. Cassettes and/or CD's may be picked up at the registration desk after each event.

Practice Ice

Practice will be available, by reservation, during designated times throughout the competition beginning Thursday, January 20, 2005. The cost of practice ice is \$8.00 per half-hour (1/2) session. Sessions will be limited to 20 skaters per session. A practice ice reservation form will be available for download through the website at www.scsouthflorida.org/competitions.htm Practice ice schedules will also be available online. If a practice session is full, you will be placed in the next available session. Practice ice fees are non-refundable. Skaters are reminded to be on-time for practice sessions. There will be a five (5) minute wait period before a skater is considered a "no show." As customary, coaches are not allowed on the ice during official practices.

Schedule

To receive a copy of your respective schedule of events include a self-addressed stamped envelope. The final schedule will be available approximately two (2) weeks prior to the event on the competition at the club's website. Schedules will also be available at the Registration Desk.

Skaters are responsible for being present at their own events, and **it is suggested that they be ready to skate at least half hour before the scheduled time.** Skating Club of South Florida, Inc. will not be responsible for missed events, and refunds will not be extended.

Video and Photography

A professional video service will be available. Those interested in video taping for personal use will be asked to use a designated area. NO electrical outlets are available and tripods will not be permitted.

Registration Desk

The registration desk will be open at Pines Ice Arena during the scheduled events. Posting of notices, changes or announcements on the club's official website shall be considered sufficient notice to the competitors. Postings will also be available at the club's bulletin board in Pines Ice Arena.

Admission to the Event

Admission to this event is FREE.

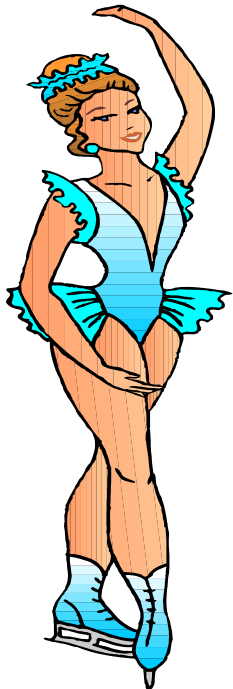
