The Cleveland Invitational Championships are held in an effort to stimulate interest in figure skating in the Cleveland area and to afford a competitive experience for as many skaters of the participating clubs in any event. The competition will be conducted according to the USFSA Rules. Skaters may skate only for their Home Club.

ELIGIBILITY: This competition is open to all Skaters whose Home Club is a member of the Greater Cleveland Council of Figure Skating Clubs (GCCFSC). Mixed Pairs and Dance Teams may skate if only one skater is a Home Club Member of the GCCFSC.

Single Skaters may skate at their Free Skating Test Level (**as of Jan. 21, 2006**) or at one level higher, BUT NOT BOTH. Single Skaters must, however, have passed the Pre-Preliminary Free Skating Test by **Jan. 21, 2006** to be eligible to compete. Skaters may not compete below their test level as of **Jan. 21, 2006**. Pairs and Dancers may not move up a level.

Pre-Preliminary through Pre-Juvenile events with a large number of entries will be divided into smaller groups by birth date. Juvenile, Intermediate, Novice, Junior and Senior events will be arranged by random draw. Winners of any CIC event may enter that event again.

ENTRY FEE: **FREE SKATING, PAIRS, COMPULSORY MOVES, SPINS, ARTISTIC SHOWCASE:**
Sixty Dollars (\$60) per competitor for the first Free Skating, Compulsory, Artistic Showcase, Spins or Pairs event. Twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) for the second event. Five Dollars (\$5.00) for any additional event.

DANCE EVENTS:

If you are entering Couples or Solo Dance **ONLY**, the fee is Twenty-Five (\$25.00) per skater for the **FIRST** Dance event. Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00) for the second event. Five Dollars (\$5.00) for any additional event.

PLEASE NOTE: There will be a \$30.00 service charge assessed for processing a NSF check. NO REFUNDS will be issued after the closing date unless an event is cancelled due to lack of participants. NO REFUNDS will be given for any other reason, INCLUDING MEDICAL.

Any skater who has signed up for the wrong event, and does not give notification until after the skating schedule has been finalized, will be assessed a \$5.00 fee. This fee will be collected at the time of registration.

- DEADLINE:** Application and entry fees **MUST be RECEIVED by DIANE MURPHY, at the Cleveland Skating Office, 5795 Tree Moss Lane, North Ridgeville, Ohio 44039. Diane Murphy can be contacted at (440-808-1995). All entries must be received on or before January 21, 2006. INCOMPLETE OR LATE ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED. January 21, 2006 is the cutoff date for determining your test level. MAIL EARLY TO MAKE DEADLINE.**
- PRACTICE ICE:** Practice Ice can be purchased from the Kathy Tagliamonte. Practice ice can be purchased in advance for \$10.00 per ½ hour by completing the practice ice order form.
- ARENA:** There are two ice surfaces measuring 85' X 200". Both rinks will be in use for the competition.
- REGISTRATION:** The official registration desk will be located in the lobby of the Civic Center Arena. **Competitors must check in 1 hour before their event.**
- ADMISSION:** There will be no charge for Admission.
- MUSIC:** Competitors should bring 2 cassette tapes. One is to be turned in at the Registration Desk and the other is to be kept by the competitor as an emergency backup. Cassettes should be rewound and have music only on one side. We would prefer C-10's or C-12's, but length up to C-30's will be accepted. **Nothing longer than C-30's will be accepted. Do not turn in C-90's. Broken or damaged cassettes will also be rejected.** CD's will also be accepted. If you have any music questions, please contact Mr. Jim Cunningham at (330) 656-3416.
- NOTE:** Please use good quality tapes, as there have been problems with less expensive ones. Skaters are required to deliver their music at the time of registration. **This must be done at the Registration Desk at least 1 hour before the skater's event.** Music should be reclaimed at the Registration Desk after the competition of the event in which it was used.

- AWARDS:** Medals will be awarded for First, Second, and Third places in all categories. In the interest of good sportsmanship and out of consideration of all medallists, it is requested that all who qualify attend award ceremonies. It is further requested that all wear their skating outfits and skates. There will be an official photographer on hand to take awards photos. There will also be ample opportunity for parents to take pictures as well.
- TROPHIES:** **TONIA KWIATKOWSKI AWARD FOR NOVICE LADIES FREESKATING TROPHY** will be presented to the winner of the Novice Ladies Freeskating Event. A traveling trophy will be presented to be displayed in the home rink of the winner. A plaque will also be presented for the winner to keep. In the event of more than one Freeskating groups of Novice Ladies, a final round consisting of the long program will be required to determine the winner of the trophy.
- THE BILL COYLE DANCE TROPHY:** will be awarded to the club winning the most points in all dance events. For Dance events with skaters from two different clubs, the points will be split.
- THE WINTERHURST MANEUVER TEAM TROPHY:** will be awarded to the club winning the most points in all maneuver team events. This trophy is a traveling trophy.

CLUB TROPHY: **THE JOY CUNNINGHAM~WILLIAM WALL CLEVELAND INVITATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP CLUB TROPHY** will be awarded to the club winning the most points. Points will be awarded as follows: 1st place-4 points, 2nd place-3 points, etc. with the number of points reduced in events with less than 4 skaters. For Dance and Pair events with skaters from two different clubs, the points will be split. Maneuver teams will not be included in the point total. This is a traveling trophy.

LIABILITY: The Mentor Figure Skating Club's liability is in accordance with USFSA Rule 3222.

Boys and Girls will compete together.

ARTISTIC SHOWCASE

The Showcase Event is divided into three divisions based upon the Free Skate test level. The skating music is chosen by the skater. **Programs should be designed specifically to entertain and/or emotionally move the audience. Theme and Music of Program needs to be described on the application form.** Costumes are encouraged. Props will be allowed and the skater will have 30 seconds to place and remove the prop. (NO PROPS ARE ALLOWED ON ICE DURING WARM-UP). Although jumps, spins and footwork should be part of the program, the program will be judged primarily on style and presentation. The theme is open and vocal music is permitted. The groups and times are as follows:

GROUP I	Pre-Prel/Prelim.	No axels, no double jumps	Time: 1-1/4 Max
GROUP II	Pre Juv/Juvenile	No double jumps	Time: 1-1/2 Max
GROUP III	Intermed/Above	May include 1 double jump	Time: 1-1/2 Max

NOTES FOR SHORT PROGRAMS AND COMPULSORY MOVES

1. No music will be played except for Juvenile, Intermediate, Novice, Junior and Senior Short Programs. The elements of the, Pre-Preliminary, Preliminary, Pre-Juvenile and Adult Compulsory Moves will be skated without music and within the time listed. Pre-Preliminary, Preliminary, Pre-Juvenile and Adult Compulsory Moves will be skated on ½ rink surface. Refer to the instructions for the Spin Compulsory Events.
2. The required elements may be skated IN ANY ORDER. Unprescribed additional jumps or spins are not permitted. Marks will be deducted if any are included.
3. Jumps and Combination Jumps * will be evaluated on:
 - (a) Speed and flow from takeoff to landing.
 - (b) Cleanness of takeoff.
 - (c) Height of jump.
 - (d) Body position in the air.
 - (e) Control of the landing.

*Combination jumps must have no steps or turns in between combined jumps.
4. Spins and Combination Spins will be evaluated on:
 - (a) Number of revolutions.
 - (b) Speed of revolutions.
 - (c) Center of spins.
 - (d) Body position in the spin.
 - (e) Control of the exit from the spin.
5. Footwork will be evaluated on:
 - (a) Difficulty of steps.
 - (b) Neatness, sureness and cleanness of steps.
 - (c) Speed of travel.
 - (d) Body position.

NOTES FOR DANCERS

1. If there are a large number of entries in any dance event, the event will be divided into groups by birth date of the older partner, or the individual in the case of Solo Dance.
2. The group of dances drawn for the Initial Round will not be used for the Final Round.
3. In the Initial and Final Rounds of all Dance events, the couples shall dance each dance one couple at a time.
4. The Referee will determine the number of patterns skated.

NOTES FOR SIMILAR PAIRS

1. This is not an artistic showcase program. Elements are to conform to USFSA rules #4010 and #4030. Vocal music with lyrics is not permitted.

MANEUVER TEAM COMPETITION**

A figure skating club may enter two teams in Juvenile, Intermediate, Novice and Junior/Senior Competition for a maximum of eight teams per club. Skaters may only skate for their home club. **BOTH BOYS AND GIRLS MAY SKATE ON ONE TEAM.** There are five members per team with one maneuver being performed by each member. Should a skater be unable to compete due to illness or injury, a teammate may do his maneuver with proper notice to the referee of this event. **There must be a minimum of four (4) skaters to compete as a team** (5 is still the number that should sign up.) **No one skater may perform more than one jump or one spin. A SKATER MAY SKATE ON ONE TEAM ONLY.** No award points will be given for maneuver team placements. Members of previous winning teams need not compete at a higher level.
