PRACTICE ICE - For Basic Skills skaters: Practice ice for Basic Skills skaters (Snow Plow Sam through Basic 8) will be available in 20 minute sessions from 10:30 am to 11:10 am. The cost will be \$4.00 per session. Advanced registration is suggested. Drop-ins will be permitted if space allows. No refunds will be given for missed practice sessions. Suburban Ice-East Lansing Learn To Skate program instructors will be on the ice with the Basic Skills skaters to guide the skaters through their practice.
