

## SECTIONAL MONITORING SESSIONS

The U.S. Figure Skating Synchronized Skating Committee is pleased to announce a series of sectional monitoring seminars. Synchronized teams competing under the ISU Judging System at sectional championships will have the opportunity to have their program evaluated by an official team comprised of a technical specialist and a technical controller. Teams will learn what improvements they can make to their programs to be successful under IJS.

**CONDUCT OF SESSIONS:** Each team will receive a 15-20 minute block of ice, in which they will be asked to perform their program. The faculty will then ask the team to repeat specific parts of the program, such as step sequences, elements, etc. The head coach of the team will then receive a conference time to return and meet with the faculty for an in-depth review of their program, including the levels of element and suggestions to increase point totals.

Eastern Section:

Pacific Coast Section:

Sunday, November 11, 2007 Anaheim ICE, Anaheim, Calif.

Midwestern Section:

Saturday, November 17, 2007 Wings Stadium, Kalamazoo, Mich.

**REGISTRATION:** Teams will sign up through U.S. Figure Skating Headquarters by completing the attached application. Slots will be assigned on a first-come-first served basis; with priority given to the U.S. Figure Skating Reserve Team (international envelope teams are not eligible for this program). Ice time is limited. Once all of the registrations have been received, U.S. Figure Skating will assign each team an ice session and a conference time. All information will be communicated via e-mail. **REGISTRATION DEADLINE IS OCTOBER 1, 2007** 

**COST:** This is a U.S. Figure Skating supported program. The cost per team is \$50, which will help contribute to paying for ice time and the travel expenses of the monitor team.

**ELIGIBILITY:** This program is open to synchronized teams competing at the open junior, intermediate, novice, junior, senior, collegiate and adult levels, with the exception of any teams in the international envelope. Teams must have plans to compete at their sectional championships to be eligible, and priority will be given to teams in the international Reserve Team.
