Eastern Great Lakes Nonqualifying Competition October 5–9, 2012

All Inclusive: One entry fee will include your event, your DVD, one practice ice session, one chaperone credential, one coach credential, a program and a pin.

Dates and Location: All Nonqualifying (NQ) events will be held concurrently with Eastern Great Lakes Regional Figure Skating Championships, October 5-9, 2012. ALL NQ events and practice ice will be held on the Olympic Rink (100 x 200) at the Ann Arbor Ice Cube.

Rules: The competition is sanctioned by U.S. Figure Skating and will be governed by the rules effective for the current competition season, except as modified in this announcement.

The competition will be conducted in accordance with the rules set forth in the 2013 edition of the U.S. Figure Skating rulebook. Test track and other information also available at www.usfigureskating.org.

The purpose of a Regional qualifying competition is to qualify skaters for Sectionals. The Local Organizing Committee (LOC) is permitted by U.S. Figure Skating to host a nonqualifying competition in conjunction with the qualifying competition. However, the LOC is required by U.S. Figure Skating to either limit the size of or be prepared to cancel certain events if they interfere with the qualifying competition. *Therefore, this nonqualifying competition will be restricted in size. All nonqualifying entries will be accepted by earliest registration and payment received.*

Judging: The 6.0 judging system will be used for all events.

Eligibility: Eligible competitors must be current members in good standing of U.S. Figure Skating and shall be eligible to enter events based on their test status (as of August 25, 2012) **or compete up one level.**

Events: Well-balanced programs: Preliminary FS; Pre-Juvenile FS; Open-Juvenile FS

Pair Teams: Pre-Juvenile Pairs

Dance Couples: Pre-Juvenile Pattern Dance

Test Track: Preliminary through Senior Test Track FS. Elements per the U.S. Figure Skating Rulebook.

Final Rounds will be held for all events having more than one flight of skaters.

The Ann Arbor Figure Skating Club (AAFSC), the Local Organizing Committee, U.S. Figure Skating, and the ice arena being utilized for these events accept no responsibility for injury or damage sustained by any participant in these championships (see Rule 1600).

Entries: Test and age requirements must be met by Sept. 1, 2012. Only online entries will be accepted. **Please register at www.sk8stuff.com.** See “EGL NQ Competition.” Online Registration closes at midnight, **August 25, 2012.** (extended to Sept. 1 without penalty for those testing end of August). **Registration is NOT complete until payment coupons are received. Forms must be postmarked no later than August 27, 2012 (or Sept. 3 for late testers).** ALL confirmation times and event notifications will be done by website posting. NO “regular” mail will be used. See www.annarborfsc.com or www.sk8stuff.com for information.

Entry Fees: Entry fees for all skaters for the NQ events are as follows:

One entry fee will include your event, your DVD, one practice ice, program and pin, and credentials.

- **\$140.00 - Singles Events**
- **\$140.00 – Per Dance or Pair Team.**
(**\$100 if already entered into a singles event**)

Entry fees are refundable only if the competition is not held, or if withdrawal of an entry is made before the close of entries.

Payment

Payment must be made by check or money order (made payable to AAFSC – EGL-NQ)

Payment coupons and agreements need to be printed from www.sk8stuff.com upon completion of the registration form. Online payments are not possible. Sorry. Persons using checks without sufficient funds will be charged an additional \$30.00 fee per check and all further payments must be made by cash or money order. Skaters will not be allowed to practice or compete until all such debts are satisfied.

Music

Only CDs will be used at this nonqualifying event. Skaters should bring at least two (2) high quality CDs per program to be performed. One CD must be turned in at the time of registration for the competition. Skaters may not receive their credentials until music has been turned in. Each CD should be labeled with the competitor's name. CDs must be picked up at the completion of the event. None will be mailed.

Practice Ice

NQ Practice ice will begin on Friday October 5, 2012 on the Olympic Rink. One session is included with your entry. Additional sessions may be pre-purchased online at the time of registration, or may be purchased at the practice ice desk during the competition. Limit: 2 sessions per day at the discretion of LOC based on availability. All practice sessions are 30 minutes long. Cost will be \$15.00 per session. Dance and Pair sessions will cost \$15.00 per skater per session. If you pre-pay for sessions and fail to reserve them online, your pre-payment may be applied towards sessions purchased at the registration desk during the competition. There is no refund for prepaid sessions, even if not used.

A schedule of practice sessions will be published online when the competition schedule is published. To ensure a fair chance for everyone, online capability for those sessions will be turned on at a time/date which will be published when the schedules are published. This turn-on time will be early evening at least 24 hours after the publication of the schedules. Online reservation capability will be turned off at 6:00 pm on the day prior to the first scheduled practice session.

To reserve your sessions online, you will log-on using a link which will be published on www.sk8stuff.com. You will need to use your name and a PIN number. (If you don't have it, there is a button next to the names dropdown that says "email me my PIN".)

Sessions will be available Friday through Tuesday and will be designated by level and discipline (FS, Dance, Pairs). You may only reserve sessions appropriate to your entry.

Checks should be made out to AAFSC—EGL-NQ. Please do not share your PIN with anyone else (neither Ann Arbor FSC nor sk8stuff.com are responsible for reservation changes made online by unauthorized users).

Credentials

Security will be on hand and entry will be limited to credentialed and ticketed individuals only.

Competitor credentials: Competitors will not receive credentials until their competition music has been turned in to registration.

Chaperone credentials: Each skater may name one chaperone to receive credentials free of charge. One additional chaperone credential may be purchased for \$35.

Coach credentials: Each singles entrant may designate a maximum of two coaches for credentials; One coach credential per competitor will be provided free of charge; all others are \$35 each. All coaches must

- Be current members of U.S. Figure Skating
- Be current PSA members
- Complete the U.S Figure Skating coach registration process
- Be Category B CER compliant

Changes: Changes to chaperone and/or coach designations may be made at the registration desk. Competitors will be limited to one chaperone and one coach designation change. Only a skater who is not a minor, or a parent or legal guardian of a minor skater may designate or change an official chaperone or coach.

Replacement: Lost credentials may be replaced for \$35.

Awards

Award medals will be presented to the 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th place finishers in each event. All winners should appear dressed in their competitive costumes with skates for the award ceremony. Check the bulletin board for award schedule and location.

Admissions

The 2013 Eastern Great Lakes Regional Championships and EGL Nonqualifying Competition will be open to the public. All-event passes are available for \$35 and daily tickets for \$10/day or \$5 after 5pm. (Children 10 and under are free; nonworking U.S. Figure Skating officials and all Seniors 65 and over are \$25/\$5.) **See Form C.**

DVDs will be produced by **Ledin Video** and are included with your entry fee. **Roger Knight Photography** will be taking stop-action photos. They will be for sale on site, but NOT online after the competition is over.

Test Track 2012-13 (effective September 1, 2012)

Skaters may enter EITHER the new test track free skate program or the well-balanced track free skate program but **NOT** both during the same nonqualifying competition. Competitors will skate to music of their choice, vocal music permitted. The 6.0 judging system will be used for all Test Track events.

Deductions **WILL** be made for skaters including technical elements not permitted in the event description.

- 0.1 from EACH mark for each technical element included that is not permitted in the event description.
- 0.2 from the technical mark for each extra element.
- 0.1 for any spin with less than required revolutions.
