Purpose: The Cleveland Invitational Championships (CICs) are held to stimulate interest in figure skating and

to afford a competitive experience for skaters. The competition will be conducted according to the current U.S. Figure Skating rules. Skaters may skate only for their Home Club. CICs is part of the Tri-

State Council Championship Series and the National Solo Dance Series.

Eligibility: Previously limited to Cleveland-area skaters, CICs is open to all skaters from any club. Skaters may

not compete below their test level as of February 9, 2013. In most cases, skaters may compete at their test level as of February 9, 2013 or at one level higher (but not both within the same category).

Read further for details.

6.0 events with a large number of entries will be divided into smaller groups by birth date. IJS events will be arranged by random draw and will have a Final Round if there are more than 24 entries (per rule #2466). Events will be divided into groups by male and female. However, the Wooster Figure Skating Club reserves the right to combine male and female skaters if there are fewer than two (2) entries in any event at the Pre-Preliminary, Preliminary and Pre-Juvenile levels. Events with only one competitor will not be held. Fees for cancelled events (only) will be refunded.

Other Fees: Please ensure you have checked the correct boxes when completing your registration form. If you

incorrectly mark a box that results in the event needing to be changed, you will be assessed a \$20 fee per changed event. Absolutely no changes will be made to the schedule after 5 days from the

fee per changed event. Absolutely no changes will be made to the schedule after 5 days from the

publication date of the schedule. There will be a service charge assessed of \$30 for all NSF checks. Cashier's check or a money order will be the only payments accepted for the fee for NSF checks.

## Event Registration:

Preferred secure on line registration by Entryeeze and credit card payment is the preferred method Please refer to <a href="www.entryeeze.com">www.entryeeze.com</a>. Entryeeze charges 3.8% for process. All entries must be postmarked by February 8, 2013 or received by midnight February 8, 2013 in entering on line. All mail in entry forms must be completely filled out and mailed along with a check or money order made payable to Wooster Figure Skating Club and mailed to 851 Oldman Road Wooster, Oh 44691. There will be a \$15 processing fee per skater for paper entry or paying via check.

Skater and coach schedule will be posted on the web at www.woosterfsc.com

Full refunds including practice ice are available if withdrawn prior to February 8, 2013. After February 8, 2013 entry refunds are only available if the competition is not held. There will be no medical refunds given.

An official bulletin board will be in the lobby of the arena near skater registration. Posting of schedules and announcements there will constitute official notice to competitors, coaches and officials. Check this upon arrival.

Practice Ice:

Practice ice will be available in  $\frac{1}{2}$  hour sessions at a cost of \$12.00 per session. Refer to the practice ice application. No music will be played during practice ice. Please check in with the ice monitor before taking the ice for practice. Practice will be available for sale during the event and will be a first come, first served basis.

IJS/PPCS:

Competitors in IJS events are required to submit a Planned Program Content Sheet (PPCS). The PPCS is to be completed online with U.S. Figure Skating before March 12, 2012. For those who do not submit a Planned Program Content Sheet online before March 12th, a \$25 processing fee per IJS event will be assessed. Please note that any PPCS submitted by paper will incur a \$25 processing fee per IJS event, regardless of date. Once entered, PPCS may be updated online at any time and as often as desired without cost up to March 12th. Please go to <a href="www.usfsa.org">www.usfsa.org</a> and log in to the Members Only section. You will need your U.S. Figure Skating number and password. Go to Event Registration and Online Event Registration, then to Event Manager and Program Content and register your forms under Cleveland Invitational Championships.

Deadline:

**Completed applications and entry fees must be postmarked by February 8, 2013**. If space permits applications <u>may</u> be accepted after this date, however a \$15 late fee will be assessed. A parent or guardian AND a club official must sign the application. Incomplete applications will not be accepted.

Facilities:

One ice surface  $85' \times 200'$  will be used for CICs. The Alice Noble Ice Arena has dressing rooms, concessions, and parking. Several vendors will be present as well as a photographer and videographer to capture those special moments.

Registration:

On the day of the competition, all skaters must check in at the Registration Desk located in the rink lobby. The Registration Desk will be open throughout the competition. Skaters should be at the rink, checked in, and ready to compete one hour prior to the scheduled time of their event.

Music:

Music will be reproduced through the arena sound system from CDs only, which are furnished by each skater. Skaters are required to deliver their music to the Registration Desk at the time of registration and at least one hour before the event warm up time. All music must be turned in properly labeled at the time of registration. Maxell brand CDs are NOT preferred. Please use the CD

type CD-R Music. The LOC will not be held responsible for CD's that do not play properly, so it is recommended that you have back-ups. All skaters should have appropriate backup music with them at rink side during their events. Music should be reclaimed at the Registration Desk following the event. All music is +/- 10 seconds unless it states maximum. Vocal music with lyrics is **not** permitted for Novice through Senior level Free Skate events.

Awards:

Medals will be awarded for 1st through 3rd place for each event including any final rounds.

**Trophies:** 

Only Greater Cleveland member clubs are eligible for the following trophies.

<u>The Bill Coyle Dance Trophy</u> will be awarded to the club winning the most points in all the dance events. For Dance events with skaters from two different clubs, the points will be split. This is a traveling trophy.

<u>The Winterhurst Maneuver Team Trophy</u> will be awarded to the club winning the most points in all maneuver team events. This trophy is a traveling trophy.

The Joy Cunningham-William Wall Cleveland Invitational Championships Club Trophy will be awarded to the club winning the most points. Points will be awarded as follows:  $1^{st}$  place -4 points,  $2^{nd}$  place -3 points,  $3^{rd}$  place -2 points,  $4^{th}$  place -1 point with the number of points reduced in events with fewer than 4 skaters. For Dance and Pair events with skaters from two different clubs, the points will be split. Maneuver teams will not be included in the point total. This is a traveling trophy.

Scoring:

The IJS system will be used for Juvenile through Senior Ladies and Men Free Skating and Juvenile through Senior Ladies and Men Short Program. The 6.0 scoring system will be used for all other events.

**Critiques:** 

Individual critiques by one judge alone with a technical specialist will be offered to skaters and coaches after each singles free skate event, Juvenile thru Senior (excluding Test Track) for a fee of \$10.

Video: Camera: Action Photos and Video will be available from **Moto Photo Photography.** Personal Videotaping may only be done from the stands with hand held cameras- no lights, tripods or taping permitted at the rink side. Photographs may be taken of the skater while performing.

<u>Directions to Alice Noble Ice Arena</u> There is a map included at the back of this application to aid you in your travels in and around Wooster.

#### From the West:

Take 30 West to the 83 North exit. Proceed approx. 4-1/2 miles to Milltown Road (second red light). Turn left on Milltown and go approx. 0.30 mile. Turn Left on Oak Hill Rd. go approx. 1/4 mile arena will be on your left.

#### From the East:

Take 30 East to the 83 North exit. Proceed approx. 4-1/2 miles to Milltown Road (second red light). Turn left on Milltown and go approx. 0.30 mile. Turn Left on Oak Hill Rd. go approx. 1/4 mile arena will be on your left.

#### From the North (route 83)

Take 83 South past the shopping area until you get to Milltown Road. Turn right on Milltown Road and go approx. 0.30 mile. Turn Left on Oak Hill Rd. go approx. 1/4 mile arena will be on your left.

## From the North (route 3)

Take 3 South to Milltown Road. Turn right on Milltown Road and go approx. 1-1/2 miles (thru 2 stop lights). Turn Left on Oak Hill Rd. go approx. 1/4 mile arena will be on your left.

## From the North (route 585)

Category

Take 585 to Portage Road (also know as Back Orville Road). There is a CVS pharmacy on the corner. Turn Right onto Portage Road and go approx. ¼ mile to the second light (K-Mart will be on the left.). Turn right onto Melrose Drive and go approx. ¾ mile to Milltown Road. Turn left on Milltown and go approx 2-1/4 miles (thru 3 stop lights crossing over route 3 and route 83. Turn Left on Oak Hill Rd. go approx. 1/4 mile. The arena will be on your left.

## **COMPULSORY SPIN EVENT**

Skaters may compete at their current free skate test level or one level higher, but **not** both (see Pre-Prelim for exception). Programs are to be skated on half ice with no music. Elements must be skated exactly as stated but may be skated in any order. Additional jumps or spins are not permitted and deductions will be taken for each occurrence. One footwork sequence allowed. Pre-Preliminary- Pre-Juvenile will be judged on 6.0 scale. Juvenile and above will be judged IJS. All times shown are maximum.

## **COMPULSORY JUMPS EVENT**

Skaters may compete at their current test level or one level higher but **not** both. Programs are to be skated with no music on half ice, for Pre-Preliminary & Preliminary, and full ice for Pre-Juvenile thru Senior. Minimum connecting steps are allowed but will not affect scoring. Only one attempt per jump is permitted. Pre-Preliminary- Pre-Juvenile will be judged on 6.0 scale. Juvenile and above will be judged IJS. All times shown are maximum. Elements marked with \* must be proceeded with footwork

## **TEST TRACK FREE SKATE EVENT**

Skaters may enter EITHER the new test track free skate program or the well-balanced track free skate program but **NOT** both during the same nonqualifying competition. Competitors will skate to music of their choice, vocal music permitted. The 6.0 judging system will be used for all Test Track events. Deductions WILL be made for skaters including technical elements not permitted in the event description. 0.1 from EACH mark for each technical element included that is not permitted in the event description. 0.2 from the technical mark for each extra element. 0.1 for any spin with less than required revolutions.

## **Solo Short Dance:**

## **Judging System for all Solo Dance Events**

The 6.0 judging system will be used for all events and levels at Solo Dance Competitions. The ISU judging system will not be used.

#### Notes on the conduct of the competition:

All dance events may be double-paneled at the discretion of the referee. When there are more than 18 athletes in a solo dance event, the event will be split so no flight has more than 18 skaters. Ladies will skate the ladies' steps and men will skate the men's steps, no exceptions.

#### Officials:

Officials will be chosen from both competition and test level judges.

## 2013 Cleveland Invitational Championships Maneuver Team Competition

A figure skating club may enter two teams in each level for a maximum of eight teams per club. Skaters may only skate for their home club. Both boys and girls may skate on one team. There are three to five members per team with one maneuver being performed by each skater and no skater should perform more than two maneuvers. Should a skater be unable to compete due to illness or injury, a teammate may do his maneuver with proper notice to the referee of this event. There must be a minimum of three skaters to compete as a team. A skater may skate on one team only. No award points will be given for Maneuver Team events.


