**ENTRIES:**

The 2026 Abby Yeagley Memorial Competition will be conducted per the rules and regulations the current Compete USA handbook as well as any pertinent updates that have been posted on the U.S. Figure Skating [website](#). This competition is open to all eligible, restricted, reinstated or readmitted persons as defined by the Eligibility Rules. Skaters must be a currently registered member of a U.S. Figure Skating member club, (if offering compete USA events) Learn to Skate USA® member, a collegiate club or who is an individual member in accordance with the current rulebook. For non-U.S. citizens, please refer to the [rulebook](#) for more information.

**ELIGIBILITY RULES FOR PARTICIPANTS:**

The competition is open to ALL skaters who are currently eligible (ER 1.00) members of either Learn to Skate USA or those who are full members of U.S. Figure Skating. Members of other organizations are eligible to compete but must be registered with Learn to Skate USA or a member club. There will be no more than six competitors maximum in an event and all six should receive an award.

**TEST LEVEL:**

Competition level is the highest test passed as of the entry deadline, in the discipline the skater is entering. Entrants may skate one level above that for which they qualify, but they may not skate down in any event. For more information, please refer to the current Compete USA Handbook and the current US Figure Skating rule book.

**AWARDS:**

Medals will be awarded to the first, second, and third-place finishers in each group. Ribbons will be awarded for placements of 4<sup>th</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> place.

**REGISTRATION:**

Registration will be online via [Sk8stuff.com](#).

Registration is a multi-step process.

**Step 1:** Fill out your registration information on Sk8stuff.com. You will upload your music to the Google link provided.

**Step 2:** Create an account with Pegula Ice Arena's Finnly registration system and register for the competition: [Pegula Ice Arena](#).

**Step 3:** Pay for the competition using Pegula Ice Arenas' Finnly registration system.

Registration is not considered complete until both music and payment have been received by Pegula Ice Arena.

**ENTRY FEES:**

Entry fees are as follows: First Regular Event-\$70.00. A fee of \$10.00 will be charged for each additional entry. All entry fees will be collected through Pegula Ice Arena's online registration system. Late entries will be accepted at the discretion of the Competition Committee. There will be an additional fee of \$30.00 for late entries.

**REFUND POLICY:**

Entry fees will not be refunded after entry unless the request is for medical reasons or if the event is canceled by the organizing party due to a lack of participants.

**DEADLINE:**

The entry deadline is March 29, 2026. Please note, there is limited space at each level and we will close entries for events as we reach that limit. All events will be filled on a first-come, first-served basis. Final late entries will close on April 13, 2026. Late entries will be accepted at the discretion of the local LOC chair. The deadline to upload music is April 13, 2026.

**SCHEDULE:**

The competition schedule will be available on our online registration website. You can access it there by logging into your [www.sk8stuff.com](#) account. A schedule will **not** be emailed to competitors. **NO changes will be made once entries have been sent to the referee. No changes will be made due to changes in family plans.**

**PRACTICE ICE:**

Practice ice will be available to purchase. Any unsold sessions will be available to purchase at the competition. Practice ice time will depend on interest. If interested, please reach out to Rachel Landers at [rvl5589@psu.edu](mailto:rvl5589@psu.edu).

**MUSIC:**

All music will be uploaded via the link on [Sk8stuff](#).

When uploading music, please name the file as follows: First name \_ Last name \_ Level \_ Event Category. For example, Rachel\_Landers\_Basic4\_ProgramwithMusic.

Failure to upload music by deadline or at all will result in a \$25 music fee. Music upload deadline is April 13, 2026.

Competitors must also have available a backup copy of their competition music on a cell phone and it must be immediately available rinkside whenever the skater competes. If the phone does not have the standard round headset connector, an appropriate adapter, such as an Apple Lightning connector or Samsung USB-C adapter is required to be attached. The phone should be presented to the music person with the file ready to play, phone in airplane mode and volume turned to maximum.

#### **REGISTRATION (DAY OF EVENT):**

Please register at the registration desk upon arrival. We ask that you arrive no more than one hour before your first event.

#### **ADMISSION/SPECTATORS:**

Spectators may attend the event. Spectators must sit in the designated seating areas. Spectators are not allowed to enter areas that are for skaters or authorized personnel.

\*SafeSport training is available through [www.usfsaonline.org](http://www.usfsaonline.org) for full members of U.S. Figure Skating (through Learn to Skate USA portal for instructors). There is no cost to this training.

The LOC will have a list of compliant coaches who are approved to receive a credential at the competition. Coaches will need to check in at the event registration table and show a government issued photo I.D. to receive a credential. If a coach cannot provide a photo I.D. and is not on the list or cannot produce the necessary documents, he or she will not be allowed a credential. There can be no exceptions to this policy.
